SHOW HORSE COUNCIL RULES – OFFICIAL RINGS

INSURANCE LEVY: Equestrian Disclaimer is to be completed by all competitors and forwarded with entries.

NO DISCLAIMER — NO ENTRY! NON NTSHA Members are required to purchase day membership at \$25.00 PER DAY

REFUNDS: Refunds are subject to the production of a Vet or Doctors certificate stating that the horse/rider was suffering a condition that would prevent them from competing. Incorrect entries WILL NOT be refunded and a \$20 administration fee will be charged.

PAYMENT: All entries must be submitted via Nominat: www.nominat.com.au. Postal & email entries will not be accepted.

COMPETITORS: All competitors compete at their own risk.

PROTEST: Any protest accompanied by a non-refundable fee of \$100 must be in writing, and handed to the Ringmaster, within 30 minutes of the incident. Ruling on the protest by the Disputes Committee will be final.

FEED & WATERING: Whilst horses are on the Reserve the feeding and watering of them is the responsibility of the owner/exhibitor.

HEALTH: All horses must be free from contagious disease. Veterinary inspections may be carried out at any time and horses which, in the opinion of the Veterinarian, show signs of contagious disease, shall, if the organisers so order, be removed from the Reserve by the exhibitor at his/her expense.

SWABBING: Maybe carried out on any horse at the organiser's discretion.

ETIQUETTE: Competitors at all times will display correct manners to judges and officials. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from the remainder of the Show and further action may be taken at the discretion of the organisers.

EQUIPMENT: Saddlery must be in a safe condition to the satisfaction of the organisers, or the competitor will not be allowed to compete

ILL TREATMENT OF HORSES: At anytime, anywhere on the Reserve, ill treatment of horses will not be tolerated and will result in automatic disqualification from further competition.

TIMES: Order of events shown in the program is a guide only. It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure they are ready for any event in which they are entering. The organisers reserve the right to vary the order and times of events as they see fit.

CHAMPIONSHIPS: The second place getters in all classes that qualify for Champion (denoted with *) must stand-by, and the horse/rider that placed second to the horse/rider sashed. Champion will be required for the judging of the Reserve Champion.

MEASURING: All horses entered in classes where height is specified must have a current SHC or EA height certificate. All Height certificates must be produced to Marshall on request before entering the Ring if not provided via Nominat entries as required.

No Certificate — No Entry. Copy of Measurement card to be attached to your entry or entry will not be accepted.

ATTIRE: To be in accordance with SHC rules. Suitable attire must be worn by all riders (jackets and plaiting is preferred in Hacking rings). Any handler or rider, who, in the opinion of the organisers, is not properly attired, will not be allowed to compete.

AGE OF COMPETITORS: for classes determined by age, age is at the day of competition.

APPROVED HEADGEAR: Riders/handlers Under 17 years of age must wear approved headgear to the current Australian (AS/NZ 3838; 1998 or European (EN 1384), or US (ASTNF 1163) standard. Riders 17 years of age and over are also permitted to wear bowlers and top hats. For EA classes, EA approved headgear must be worn by all riders. Top hats are not approved to be worn in EA classes.

LED CLASSES: Horse's age as at 1 August. Thoroughbred/ASH/QH/RPSB/Welsh/Arab — Horses entered in these classes MUST have been registered. However registration does not need to be current or financial. Copy of registration certificate to be included with entries. Only horses that are not eligible for a specific breed class are eligible for the "Any Other Breed " class.

JUNIOR RIDERS: Riders/handlers Under 17 years of age are not permitted to wear long boots in rider classes and Smartest on Parade. This includes gaiters and chappettes. Junior Handlers must wear approved headgear in led classes.

LEADING REIN: Pony can n/e 12.2hh and must be ridden by a child under 8 years on the day of show, snaffle bridle only and attendant must fix the leading rein to the noseband; and at all times lead with the rein in the left hand; string or any aid

fastened to the saddle to keep the pony's head in position is not permitted; No spurs or whips; Handler may carry a cane. Rider are not permitted to ride in any "off-lead" classes at this show.

SHC RIDER AND HACK AND HUNTER CLASSES: Riders must be a financial NTSHA member and Horses must be currently registered with SHC. Hacks and hunters are also required to hold a current official SHC measurement card. Winners will be eligible for Champion. SHC classes are run by NTSHA Under SHC rules & regulations. Contact NTSHA for further information: ntshowhorseassoc@gmail.com.

EA CLASSES: Riders must be a financial EA member members and horses must hold a current EA measurement card. Winners will be eligible for Champion.

PRELIMINARY HACK, HUNTER, RIDER CLASSES: is one that has not been placed 1st, Champion or Reserve in an Open ridden Hack class/event at any Royal Show or has never been the Winner or Runner Up at the Grand National, any State HOTY Title or has never been the Winner of any HOTY Intermediate or Preliminary Title. This Preliminary definition also applies to Working Hunter horses in the relevant competition.

FIRST RIDDEN PONY CLASSES: Ponies are not to exceed 12.2 hh, aged three years & over, ridden by a child aged 5 yrs & under 12 yrs judging will be on the suitability of the mount for the rider. A snaffle bit must be used, with a cavesson noseband, a narrow strap may be attached to the front of the saddle. Cane to not exceed 40cm, no spurs permitted.

HUNTER / HACK CLASSES: Horses may only compete as either a Hack or Show Hunter **NOT BOTH**.

WORKING HUNTER

Each Working Hunter Class consists of a Jumping, Flat Work and a Led/Handler phase. The classes are judged on a point system out of 100pts, with points distributed as follows:

- 50pts Jumping
- 20pts Flat work
- 10pts Presentation
- 20pts Conformation and manners

The working hunter is to move freely around 5 jumps in a controlled fast canter. Making sure all jumps are approached safely with a smooth action over the jump. When competing in the flat work, manners transitions and even movement needs to be displayed. This is not a timed event.

The Champion Working Hunter of the Show is awarded to the highest point scorer from Novice, Working Hunter Pony, Intermediate and Open Classes.

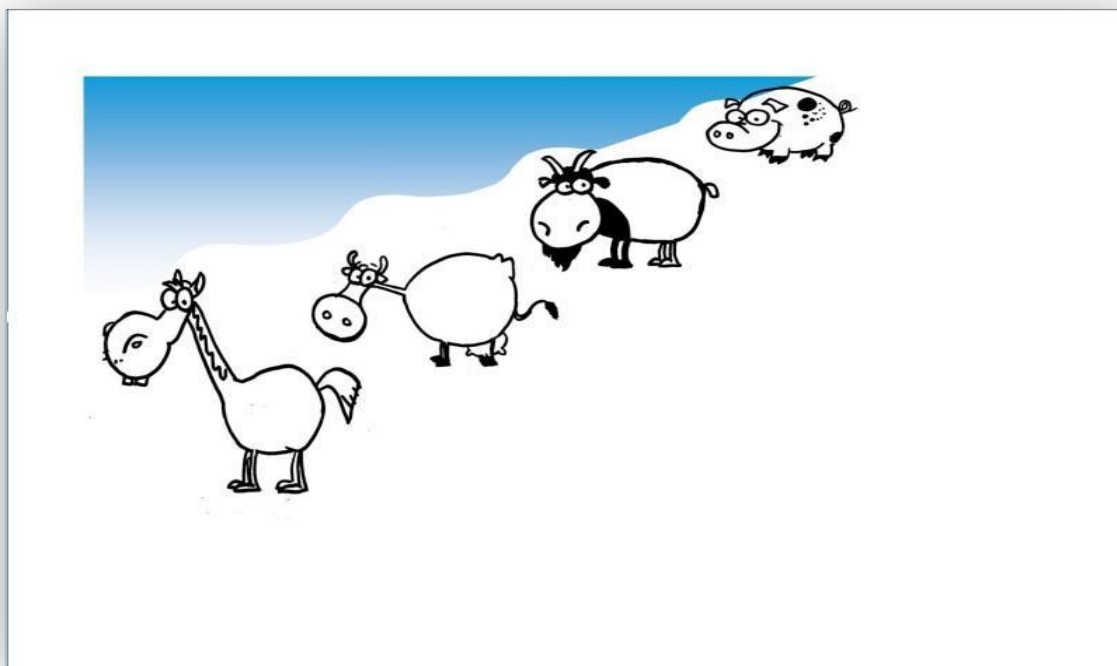

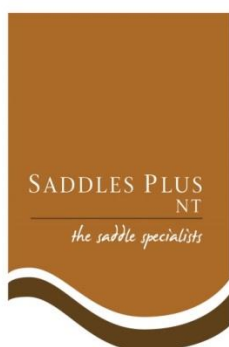
